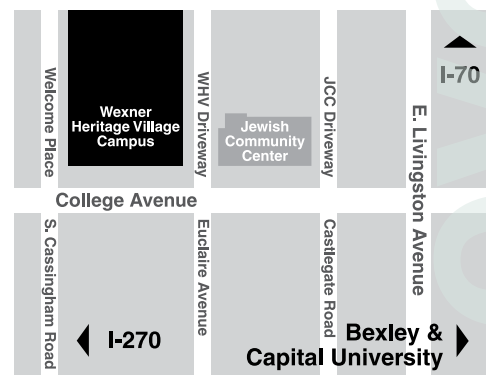
## Directions
