Wexner Heritage Village Recognizes Exceptional Contributors and Receives \$100,000 Gift at 2012 Annual Meeting

COLUMBUS, OHIO – At the Wexner Heritage Village 2012 annual meeting held Wednesday, two exceptional contributors were recognized, four new board officers were installed, and a \$100,000 gift to the organization's *Campaign to Revolutionize Care* was announced.

Wexner Heritage Village presented the ***Eleanor & Jack Resler Life with Dignity Award*** to **James A. Bowman** for his outstanding devotion and commitment to Wexner Heritage Village, and ***The Chair's Award*** was presented to the **Lewin Family** and **Hamilton Parker Company**, in grateful appreciation of their continuing partnership with Wexner Heritage Village.

WHV board member and Finance Committee Chair **Eric Wasserstrom** assumed the chairmanship of the WHV Board of Directors, succeeding **Randall Arndt**, who was named a Lifetime Director, in perpetuity. Wasserstrom is president of **N. Wasserstrom and Sons** and also serves on the boards of the **Columbus Jewish Federation**, the **Wexner Foundation**, and the **Food Equipment Manufacturer's Association**.
